SUPER TUSCANES

Supertuscans appeared in the 1970's, as the unofficial prestige wine in Tuscany. At that time, the wine laws in Tuscany made it so that quantity, rather than quality, was the focus of the winemakers. However, those that preferred the idea of making wine based on quality, and in choosing their own grapes and methods decided to break the rules and created award-winning wines-of which perhaps the best known is Bolgheri with Sassicaia (1968) and Antinori's Tignanello (1971). They became very well-known and liked throughout the area, even though they could only be classed as table wine. They gained the name "Supertuscans".

CHAMPAGNE

It is solely in the Champagne region that Champagne can be made! It is the unique combination of climate, soil, grape variety, and production technique that give this amazingly complex and unique sparkling wine. Only three grapes are allowed: chardonnay, pinot noir and pinot meunier, and most often it is a mix of all three. If it says Blanc de Blancs on the label, it is only made from chardonnay. If it says Blanc de Noir, it is only the blue grape, meaning Pinot noir and Pinot meunier.
